WHETHER YOU WANT TO DRIVE OR FLY INTO OUR REGION, THERE ARE PLENTY OF OPTIONS. WITH THREE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN CLOSE PROXIMITY, AND ONE DOMESTIC AIRPORT LINKING OUR REGION TO BOTH NORTH QUEENSLAND AND VICTORIA, ACCESSING OUR REGION HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER.

Air

The region is easily accessed via the commercial domestic airport in Toowoomba (Wellcamp Airport) which is serviced by Qantas, Rex Regional Airlines and Bonza. With regular flights from Melbourne, Townsville, and the Whitsundays with Bonza, its easy and affordable to get right into the heart of the region. The international Airports of Brisbane, Gold Coast, and Sunshine Coast, make accessing the region possible for international travellers.

All roads lead to Southern Queensland Country, including the Cunningham, New England, Warrego, Leichhardt, D'Aguilar, Brisbane Valley and Gore Highways and the Great Inland Way and the Adventure Way.

Rail

Queensland Rail operates The Westlander into our region, travelling across the Great Dividing Range to Toowoomba, through the rich farmlands of the Darling Downs, before continuing onto its final destination, Charleville.

Our region is home to two steam railways, servicing the Toowoomba, Southern Downs, and Goondiwindi regions.

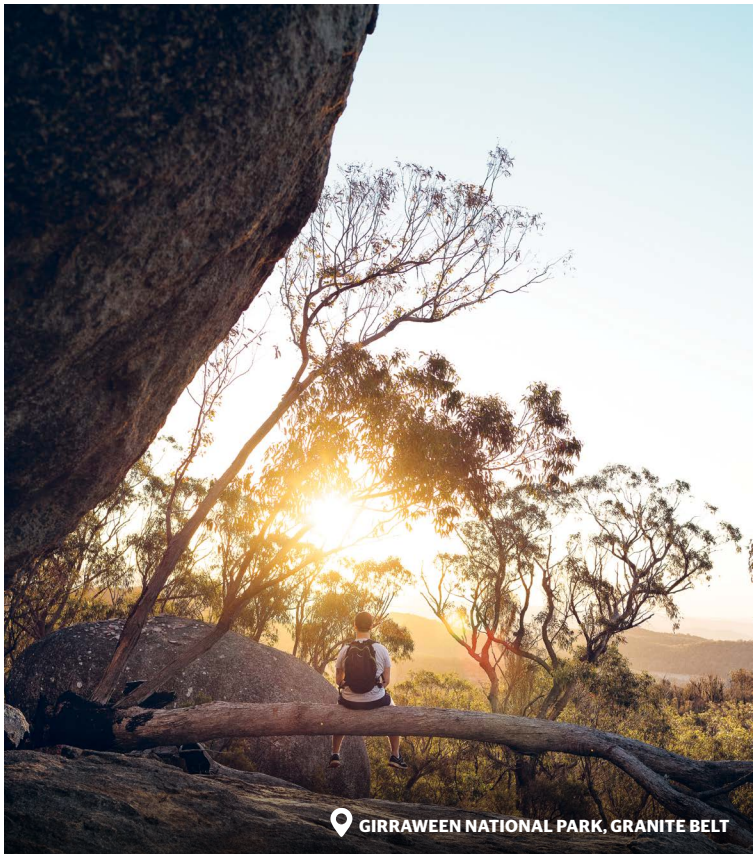
